Shreyans Prakash was declared the winner (Camouflage) with the photograph below.

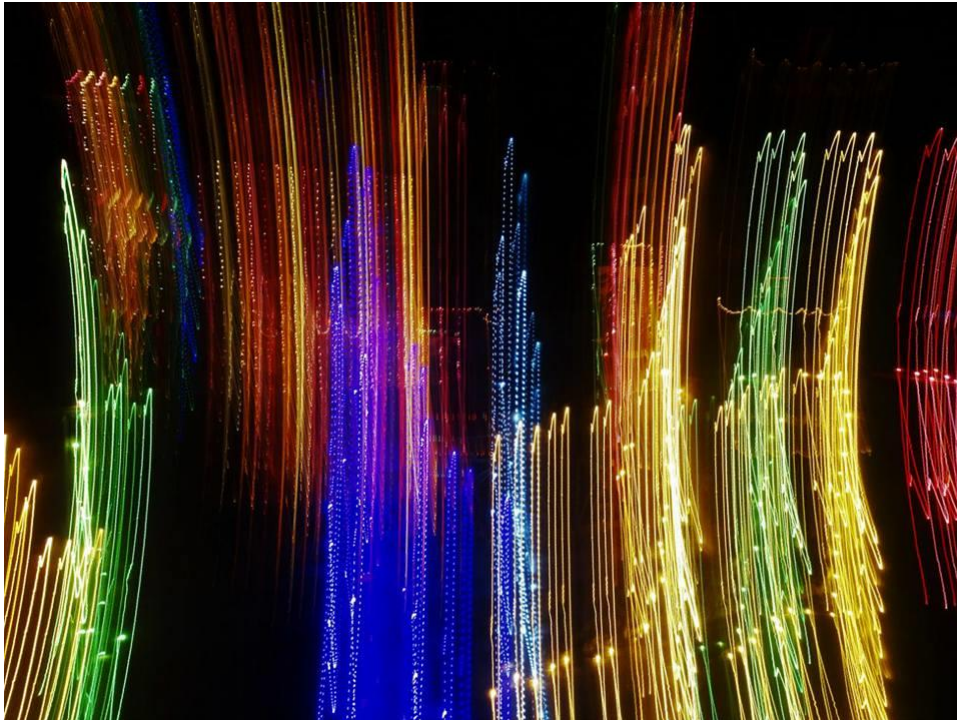


Vidhi Sehrawat was also declared the winner (Waves) with the photograph below.
